

Healing Scriptures

Healing is for today—Jesus paid for it on the cross, and God’s promises remain active for believers who receive them by faith and stay in full obedience to His Word. Here’s a short, powerful list in KJV only with brief explanations:

Exodus 15:26 (KJV): “...I am the LORD that healeth thee.”

God declares Himself that He is Healer today.

Psalms 103:2-3 (KJV): “Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.”

Healing is one of God’s ongoing benefits for you right now.

Proverbs 4:20-22 (KJV): “My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.”

God’s Word itself brings health and life to you in your obedience to His Word.

Isaiah 53:5 (KJV): “But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.”

Jesus already took our sickness on the cross—your healing was purchased then and is available now.

James 5:14-15 (KJV): “Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up...”

This instruction is for the church today—prayer brings healing.

1 Peter 2:24 (KJV): “Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.”

Past tense—“were healed.” It’s a done deal through Christ’s finished work.
